



Ballinger/Robert Lee triangle - 101.5 miles

San Angelo to Ballinger then to Robert Lee is relatively flat and with few curves, but the road from Robert Lee to San Angelo is Scenic and has some nice curves. Traffic is relatively light, though the road from San Angelo to Ballinger can get busy. There are a couple of nice places to breakfast or lunch in Ballinger as well as Lowake Stake house in Rowena.

Good Starting point: Stripes 1606 La Follett St. Head east on Houston Harte freeway and merge onto N US Hwy 67. Follow 67 to Ballinger. Turn left at the county courthouse onto TX 158 and go west till you get to Bronte. In Bronte you'll turn right (north) on US 277 and go five blocks then turn left back onto TX 158 (Stripes on your right, traffic signal). Continue to head west on TX 158 till you get to Robert Lee. In Robert Lee turn left (south) onto TX 208. Take 208 back to San Angelo.

Fuel available: San Angelo, Ballinger, Bronte and Robert Lee
