



### **Sterling City - 107 miles**

First take the road to Robert Lee, which has lots of curves and scenic roads. Then take 158 towards Sterling City. This road is scenic but mostly straight, though there is a nice elevation change close to Sterling City where you suddenly find yourself surrounded by windmills. On 87 you can turn left back towards San Angelo or you can detour into Sterling City. There used to be a nice cafe in downtown Sterling City but it keeps changing hands so I don't know much about it. There can be a good bit of traffic from Sterling City to San Angelo.

Good starting point: Stripes, 802 E 19th Street. Take Armstrong Street (TX 208) north to Robert Lee, Make a sharp left (south) onto TX 158 towards Sterling City. Turn left when 158 dead ends onto US 87. Take US 87 back to San Angelo, Refueling available in San Angelo, Robert Lee, Sterling City, and Water Valley
